3. Training flights

Entry Fee includes airplane rent for competition flights and one 15 minutes training flight.

Additional training flights will be possible on prior requests depending on time and airplanes availability. Cost: €450 per hour including fuel.

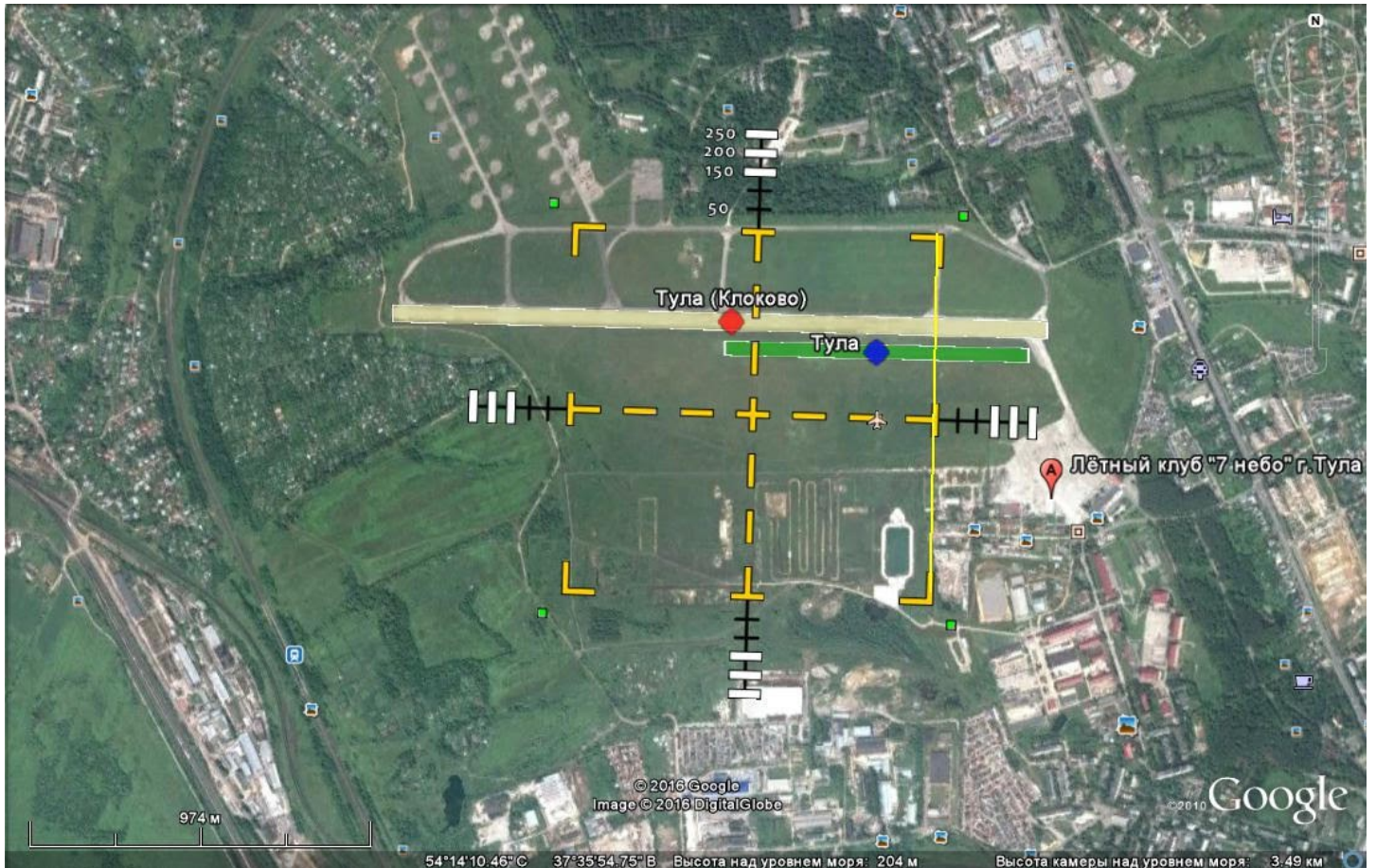
If a team or a pilot plan to organize training flights on its own aircraft, only fuel and oil cost is to be paid for training flights:

- petrol B-91/115 - 1.60 € per liter;
- oil AeroShell W100 - 4.00 € per liter.

Training flights will take place from 05th to 08th July.

Application for a training flight should be made before 1st May 2017 on email: tula-aerobatics@mail.ru.

5. The Championship will be conducted according to the following rules:

- FAI Sporting Code General Section;
- FAI Sporting Code Section 6 Part 1;
- Flight Rules Issued by Russian Federation Aviation Authorities;
- Local Regulations.

6. Official Language

English will be the official language at the championships.

In all interpretations the English version of the FAI Sporting Code and the CIVA Regulations will prevail.

Information will be published and briefings will be conducted in English.

Radio communications will be conducted in English.

Competition frequency will be defined at a later date.

7. Requirements

Competing Pilots:

Competing pilots will be accepted from FAI Member Clubs.

FAI Member Club may send maximum 8 pilots (1.2.4.2.b, Section 6, FAI Sporting Code).

The solo entries are allowed for FAI Sporting License holders from FAI Member Clubs.

All competitors have to be a holder of:

- Pilot License (PPL, CPL) - valid for Russian Federation *.
- A valid FAI Sporting License.
- A valid personal insurance policy, valid for Russian Federation.

* - Organizing Committee can assist you with validation of Pilot License.

To apply for assistance, you need to send copies of your passport, Pilot License, medical conclusion before April 01, 2017 by e-mail to tulaaerobatics@mail.ru and mr-aerobatics@mail.ru.

8. Aircraft crossing the state border of the Russian Federation

If the team plans to arrive on its own aircraft, please, let us know about it before March, 01, 2017 by e-mail at tula-aerobatics@mail.ru.

Rules on crossing the Russian Federation border by private aircraft will be sent upon request.

9. Team Members and Observers:

Officials, as defined in FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1, may enter as Team Members

Relatives of competitors will be accepted as Observers of the National Team.

Number of Team Members and Observers is not limited.

The entry fee for observers is the same as the one for regular team members.

10. Aircraft

The competition is conducted using aircraft comparable with the YAK-52 standard configuration. The aircraft must comply with FAI Sporting Code Section 6 Part 1, 1.2.3.3.

Organizers provide airplanes for all competitors of all teams for competition flights and one 15 minutes training flight. Additional training time is to be arranged by prior agreement.

In case of own aircraft use, the following documents must be submitted to the Organizer for every competing aircraft:

- A valid certificate of airworthiness or equivalent document issued by the aviation authority of the related country *;
- A valid registration certificate or equivalent document issued by the aviation authority of the related country *;

* - A valid certificate of airworthiness, valid registration certificate and Pilot License must be of the same country!

- Insurance against Third Party Liability covering a minimum limit of 2.000.000 Euro, valid for Russian Federation for the period of staying in Russian Federation.

11. Organizer supplies fuel and oil for competition flights

- Fuel: petrol B-91/115;
- Oil: AeroShell W100.

12. Entry and Entry Fees

Please send Preliminary Entry Forms to: tula-aerobatic@mail.ru and/or mr-aerobatics@mail.ru no later than March 1, 2017.

In order for the organizer to be able to help with flights_authorization competitors have to send their applications including copies of passport, Pilot License, medical conclusion, aircraft certificates of registration, airworthiness and third party liability insurance:

- No later than March 1, 2017 if you are planning to come to Russia with your aircraft;
- No later than April 1, 2017 if you are planning to rent airplanes in Russia;

Registration deadline for other team members and observers: May 9, 2017

Official Entry Forms together with NAC confirmation and full payment of the Entry Fee has to be received by the Organizer by June 9, 2017.

Registration will be confirmed after FULL payment of Entry Fee is cleared by the Organizer's bank.

Note 1: Please reserve enough time for your bank transfer.

Entry fee:

- Entry fee for the pilot - € 1500.
- Entry fee for team members and observers - € 1200.
- Entry fee for pilot using their own aircraft - € 1000.

Note 2: Entry fee must be paid prior to 09.06.2017.

Note 3: If you pay the entry fee after this date payment amount increases by 200 EUR!

The entry fee includes:

- shared accommodation 08—16 July 2017;
- continental breakfast, lunch, dinner, beverages;
- transfers hotel-airfield-hotel;
- aircraft for four competition and one training flight of 15 min;
- fuel and oil for these flights;
- participation in all events arranged by the organizer;
- CIVA sanction fee (160 € per pilot).

Single room will be charged by additional fee of 200 EUR

13. Free Known sequence submission

The Free Known sequence of each competitor should be submitted not later than at the opening briefing according to FAI Sporting Code, Section 6 Part 1.

Organizer would like to avoid delays in the beginning of the Championship due to paperwork issues with Known Free programme. Competitors may submit their Free Known sequence to the e-mail address tula-aerobatics@mail.ru, mr-aerobatics@mail.ru starting May 9, 2017. Every submission will be confirmed. Sequence submissions are not valid without confirmation.

14. Protests

Protest can be submitted by paying € 100.

15. Visa

Participants must check if the visa is needed to enter the Russian Federation.

Organizers will issue necessary support letters (letters of invitation) on request (E-mail: tula-aerobatics@mail.ru, mr-aerobatics@mail.ru)
